OOTA's Continuing Education Opportunities Gives You:

- **National and local speakers** on a variety of topics that are relevant to OK occupational therapy practitioners.
- **The two-day annual conference** alternates yearly between OKC and Tulsa.
- **Less traveling for continuing education**
The two continuing education offerings each year are broadcast in Tulsa and OKC (can be broadcast to Enid and Ft. Cobb if request is made two weeks in advance) so you can participate in real time sessions with a speaker on either end! OOTA will add additional sites as desired by members.
- **Special Interest Section meetings** in specialized areas of practice such as Hands, Pediatrics, and Mental Health, adding more continuing education credits to your portfolio
- **Reciprocity of membership** for state meetings in other participating states - go to their conferences for a "member" rate.
- **Members receive a discount** on continuing education offerings.

OOTA's Advocacy:

- **Voice for Oklahoma OT's** at the state and national levels for issues related to reimbursement, policy changes and awareness of OT.
